WASHOE SENIOR RIDE

Taxi Program:

Washoe Senior Ride (WSR) is a subsidized taxi program of the Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) and is funded by the ¼% of Washoe County sales tax that is allocated for public transportation. WSR provides alternative, reliable and affordable transportation to Washoe County residents who are 60 years and older, RTC ACCESS client (any age) and Washoe County Veterans (any age).

Each month WSR participants may purchase up to \$60 worth of taxi fares for just \$15. Participants are issued an RTC WSR CardONE reloadable card, which can be used to pay any part of a taxi fare. The WSR CardONE card cannot be used to tip the driver. This program and the subsidy are subject to available funding and may be changed or terminated by the RTC.

RTC Washoe-Uber or Lyft Rides Program

Uber or Lyft Rides Program:

RTC of Washoe County entered into an agreement with Uber or Lyft to provide Reno-Sparks rider's greater flexibility and more options for their transportation needs. The RTC Washoe-Uber or Lyft Rides program was modeled after the existing RTC Washoe Senior Ride program, but instead of taxis, we partnered with Uber or Lyft. This program is funded by the 1/4% of Washoe County sales tax that is allocated for public transportation.

Through this program, RTC of Washoe County will subsidize 75% of your fare (up to \$9) for trips on Uber or Lyft that start and end in the Reno-Sparks area. With this program, eligible customers may now use Uber of Lyft at a substantially discounted rate with a portion of the ride subsidized by the RTC of Washoe County.

Program eligibility:

This program provides alternative, reliable and affordable transportation to Washoe County residents who are 60 years and older, RTC ACCESS client (any age) and Washoe County Veterans (any age).

RTC Travel Training Program

RTC's Travel Training program is a comprehensive instruction delivered by Travel Trainers on a one-toone basis that teaches seniors and individuals with disabilities how to travel independently on public transit. Participants will receive public transportation information and training, and support centered on the safe and independent use of public transportation. Available for riders over 60 or with a disability. Travel Training focuses on the public transit routes that an individual would take between home and school, shopping employment or medical appointments. It is a fundamental precursor to achieving self-determined transition outcomes in education, employment, independent living and community integration. For FREE Travel Training, call (775) 348-0477.

RTC ACCESS

Paratransit service that provides door-to-door, prescheduled transportation for people who meet the eligibility criteria of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). RTC ACCESS passengers have disabilities which prevent them from riding RTC RIDE independently some or all of the time.
