

- Urban Washoe and Carson City
- Rural Douglas, Lyon and Storey
- Frontier Churchill, Elko, Humboldt, Lander and Pershing



Until 2022, our primary service areas will be Washoe County & Carson City







Eligibility

- Applicant must own their home, live in it as their primary residence and intend to remain in the home for at least two years following completion of the work
 - Proof of insurance current homeowner insurance policy declaration
 - Bank statement
 - Identification
- Acceptable proof of income includes, but is not limited to, past year income tax statements, payroll stubs, social security or disability statements, pension and/or veteran benefits statements, alimony or child support statements, AFDC statements and proof of any rental income or other assets.
- The total gross combined income for all residents (18+ years) in the home cannot exceed the amounts shown in the table below. (max 80% AMI)
- Proof of ownership includes current property tax statement, current homeowner insurance policy, or current mortgage statement, title, or certificate of ownership

1 person - \$47,400	2 persons – \$54,150	3 persons - \$60.900	4 persons - \$67,700
5 persons - \$73,100	6 persons - \$78,500	7 persons - \$83,900	8 persons - \$89,350

• Determined on case-by-case basis

Safety buckets

- Provide safety buckets to low- and moderate-income homeowners
- Buckets include items such as flashlight, plug in night lights, small convenient-size fire extinguisher, safety nonslip strips for shower/tub, disposable masks, sanitizing wipes
- Property must be in Washoe County

Signature Rebuilding Days
