13	POINTS AND AUTHORITIES		
14	NRS §40.385 provides:		
15	1. Either party may appeal an order entered pursuant to NRS 40.253,		
16	40.254 or 40.2542 by filing a notice of appeal within 10 judicial days after the date of entry of the order.		
17	2. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a stay of execution may be obtained by filing with the trial court a bond in the amount of \$250		
18	to cover the expected costs on appeal.	A surety upon the bond submits	
19	to the jurisdiction of the appellate court and irrevocably appoints the clerk of that court as the surety's agent upon whom papers affecting the		
20	surety's liability upon the bond may be served. Liability of a surety may be enforced, or the bond may be released, on motion in the appellate		
21	court without independent action. A tenant of commercial property may		
22	obtain a stay of execution only upon the issuance of a stay pursuant to Rule 8 of the Nevada Rules of		
23	Appellate Procedure and the posting of a supersedeas bond in the amount of 100 percent of any unpaid rent claim of the landlord.		
24	3. A tenant who retains possession of the premises that are the subject		
25	of the appeal during the pendency of the appeal shall pay to the landlord rent in the amount provided in the underlying contract		
26	between the tenant and the landlord as it becomes due. If the tenant		
27	fails to pay such rent, the landlord may initiate new proceedings for a summary eviction by serving the tenant with a new notice pursuant to NRS 40.253, 40.254 or 40.2542.
