10 Pursuant to the requirements of NRS 200.485, NRS 202.360, and 18 U.S.C. § 921(a)(33),  
 11 you are hereby notified that you are prohibited from owning, possessing or having under your  
 12 custody or control any firearm. You are further notified that violation of this order is a **Category**  
 13 **B felony** and shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for a minimum term of not  
 14 less than 1 year and a maximum term of not more than 6 years and may further be punished by a  
 15 fine of not more than \$5000; THEREFORE:

17                                    IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that you must permanently surrender, sell, or transfer any  
 18 and all firearms that you own, in your possession, or under your control not later than **24 hours**  
 19 from the date of this order in the following manner as indicated by the corresponding checkmark:  
 20

21  1. Surrender any firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control to the Reno Police  
 22 Department until July 1, 2018, and thereafter at the Reno or Sparks Police Departments,  
 23 Washoe County Sheriff’s Office, or another law enforcement agency. The law  
 24 enforcement agency shall provide you with a receipt which includes a description and  
 25 serial number of each firearm surrendered; **or**

2. Surrender any firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control to the following person:  
 \_\_\_\_\_ . In this circumstance, you shall

1 provide to this Court and to either the Reno Police Department, Sparks Police  
2 Department, Washoe County Sheriff's Office, or another law enforcement agency the  
3 name and address of the person to whom each firearm was surrendered, along with a  
4 description and serial number of each firearm surrendered; **or**

6  3. Sell or transfer any firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control to a licensed firearm  
7 dealer as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 923(a). The licensed firearm dealer shall provide you  
8 with a receipt which includes a description and serial number of each firearm  
9 surrendered.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that not later than **72 hours or one business day**, which-  
11 ever is later, after the surrender, sale, or transfer of any such firearm, you shall provide the  
12 receipt and/or documents described in the checked paragraph above to this Court from the person  
13 or entity to whom any such firearm was surrendered, sold, or transferred.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event you currently do not own or have any  
16 firearm(s) in your possession, custody, or control, you shall execute the subsequent Declaration  
17 Under Penalty of Perjury.
