<u>Possible Changes to the Agenda and Timing.</u> The P25 Joint Operating Committee may consider items on the agenda out of order. may combine two or more agenda items for consideration, may remove an item from the agenda or may delay discussion of an item on the agenda at any time.

<u>Public Comment.</u> Public comments are welcomed during the Public Comment periods at the beginning and end of the meeting for all matters, whether listed on the agenda or not. Additionally, public comment specific to the action item being considered will be heard during individual action items on the agenda. Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes per person per comment period. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers.

Members of the public may submit public comment by either attending the meeting in person, attending the meeting via teleconference or attending by telephone only. To provide public comment via Teams, log into the Teams Meeting at the above link and utilize the "Raise Hand" feature during any public comment period. To provide public comment via telephone only, press \*5. Press \*6 to mute/unmute.

Additionally, persons are invited to submit comments in writing by emailing Sharon Ruff at <a href="mailto:sruff@washoecounty.gov">sruff@washoecounty.gov</a>. The County will make reasonable efforts to send all email comments received by 4:00 p.m. on December 14, 2022, to the Committee members prior to the meeting.

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business. The P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee conducts the business of Washoe County and its citizens during its meetings. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.

Responses to Public Comments. The P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by the P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee. However, responses from P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee members to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. To avoid this situation and to ensure the public has notice of all matters the P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee will consider, P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee members may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for Washoe County staff action or to ask that a matter be listed on a future P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee meeting agenda. The P25 Radio System Joint Operating Committee may do this either during the Public Comment item or during the following item: "P25 RADIO SYSTEM JOINT OPERATING COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND/OR STAFF ANNOUNCEMENTS, REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION AND SELECTION OF TOPICS FOR FUTURE AGENDAS [Non-action item]."
