Draft minutes were not available for the Committee to review or take action on.



He reviewed the presentation for this item providing the updates on the system and the available LIDS. Additional sources of interference are being actively addressed.



SYSTEM STATUS UPDATE



- **Radio Service Interruptions**
 - BDA Interference is ramping up and team working on find source of issues. Team is actively working to clean noise floor as we wait to gain access to sites for maintenance.
 - Backhaul Maintenace caused console outages in early July. Team is working on improving backhaul routes to mitigate this issue
- Site Maintenance is underway
 - All generator and air conditioning preventative maintenance is complete. Site infrastructure preventative maintenance is 50% complete and on going.
- Microwave Remediation August
 - Microwave repair is being scheduled for mid August. Dates will be communicated once confirmed. Repair of Peavine to Sparks microwave will not cause service interruptions

 - Repair of Peavine to Virginia Peak microwave will force Virginia Peak, Marble Bluff, and Fox Mountain into Stand-alone operations for the duration of the work.
