How to Get Copies of Agenda and Supporting Materials. Possible Changes to the Agenda and Timing. The 800 MHz Joint Operating Committee may consider items on the agenda out of order, may combine two or more agenda items for consideration, may remove an item from the agenda, or may delay discussion of an item on the agenda at any time. Items scheduled to be heard at a specific time will be heard no earlier than the stated time but may be heard later.

Public Comment. Public comments are welcomed during the Public Comment periods at the beginning and end of the meeting for all matters, whether listed on the agenda or not. Additionally, public comment specific to the action item being considered will be heard during individual action items on the agenda. Public comments are limited to three (3) minutes per person per comment period. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers. Please note that USB drives or any other digital media will not be accepted from members of the public due to the risk of introducing viruses or malicious code, which could potentially compromise the County's systems.

Members of the public may submit public comment by either attending the meeting in person, attending the meeting via teleconference, or attending by telephone. To provide public comment via Teams, log into the Teams Meeting at the above link and utilize the "Raise Hand" feature during any public comment period. To provide public comment via telephone only, press *5 to raise your hand and *6 to mute/unmute.

Additionally, persons are invited to submit public comments in writing by emailing Sharon Neville and Chelsea Houston at ts-meetings@washoecounty.gov. The County will make reasonable efforts to send all email comments received by 4:00 p.m. on the business day before the meeting, to the Committee members prior to the meeting.

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business. The 800 MHz Joint Operating Committee conducts the business of Washoe County and its citizens during its meetings. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient, or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place, and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.

Responses to Public Comments. The 800 MHz Joint Operating Committee can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly prohibit responses to public comments by members of the Committee. However, responses from 800 MHz Joint Operating Committee members to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. To avoid this situation and to ensure the public has notice of all matters the 800 MHz Joint Operating Committee will consider, the Committee may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for Washoe County staff to provide information, or to ask that a matter be listed on a future 800 MHz Joint Operating Committee meeting agenda.

Special Accommodations. Persons with disabilities who require special accommodations or assistance (e.g., sign language, interpreters or assisted listening devices, etc.) at the meeting should notify Washoe County Technology Services, Sharon Neville and Chelsea Houston, by emailing ts-meetings@washoecounty.gov or by leaving a message at 775-328-2350 at least 48 hours before the meeting so that arrangements/accommodations can be made.
