# SUBJECT: Utilization of WCRCS Infrastructure Fund

A review discussion and possible action to recommend that the 800 MHz Joint Operating Committee approve, deny or otherwise modify the utilization of \$750,000 from the Washoe County Regional Communication System Infrastructure fund as a partial payment of Washoe County's second milestone payment as defined in the System Purchase Agreement between Washoe County and Harris Corporation, dated September 27, 2018.

#### **SUMMARY:**

In partnership with the Nevada Department of Transportation and NV Energy, Washoe County has committed to building a statewide public safety radio system. As part of Washoe County's commitment the county must adhere to scheduled milestone payments (see table below) as defined in the System Purchase Agreement between Washoe County and Harris Corporation, dated September 27th, 2018. Washoe County has paid the initial milestone payment of \$533,981,25. For Fiscal Year 19-20 Washoe County is requesting that the Joint Operating Committee commit \$750,000 from the WCRCS infrastructure fund to partially cover the second milestone payment. Washoe County will pay the remaining portion of the milestone payment, \$275,244, plus the project management and oversight expenses estimated to be \$220,000 for fiscal year 2020.

The current WCRCS infrastructure fund balance is \$1,078,719.01. The current WCRCS Expansion fund balance is \$206,386.67. If the JOC approves utilization of the requested amount from the infrastructure fund, the remaining balance would be \$328,719.01, leaving a total balance of \$535,108.68 for the combined infrastructure and expansion fund balances.
