- 4. NEVADA SHARED RADIO SYSTEM UPDATE** [For Discussion Only] – A review and discussion on the progress of Washoe County, NDOT and NV Energy on Nevada Shared Radio System project, including but not limited to, progress of planning, design and construction activities in Region 2 of NSRS, end-user equipment installation and programming, and project expenses. *Quinn Korbolic & Melissa Lawney – Washoe County Technology Services*

Melissa Lawney, Washoe County Technology Services, reviewed her presentation providing project updates focused on the solar installation at Fox Mountain; microwave installations, deployment schedule, and testing; P25 site and Dispatch implementations. The WCRCS team would be visiting the sites with consoles. The Radio Shop will be relocating to 224 Edison to allow all the radio staff to be in one building and also provide space for the Harris team beginning in October. It was shared that longer lead times were being experienced on most purchases with four months or more for delivery. Upcoming training opportunities and the plan for on-line and train-the-trainer events were shared. Region Two Cut-over is still targeted for March 2024; the schedule for Regions Three, member acceptance, legacy equipment removal, and storage of decommissioned equipment were reviewed.

Chair Mullen asked if RPM2 would be kept or if a new programming software was expected. Ms. Lawney said she would need to check. An UAS integration was going to be added to MCM which should help with maintaining data.
