Five-Year master plan review and update

- NRS requires that the Board of County Commissioners annually review and, if necessary, update the E911 Five-year master plan.
 - The current plan was updated in 2018 but does not reflect recent changes, 911 Committee actions, or other events:
 - 2019 NV Legislative changes
 - Committee action to replace existing Computer Aided Dispatch
 - Agency actions to expand PSAP capacities/move PSAP to new location – potentially negating the need for a dedicated PSAP backup site
 - 911 fund balance and surcharge review



Five-Year Master Plan update Process

- Washoe County Staff responsibilities:
 - Work with 911 Committee members and 911 stakeholders to develop a set of requirements for the plan update
 - Publish a request for bids to update the plan
 - Review bids with 911 Committee/stakeholders
 - Recommend a vendor to the 911 committee based on stakeholder review.
 - November, 2020.



Recommendation & Possible Motion

- **Recommend** that the 911 Emergency Response Advisory Committee recommend to the Board of County Commissioners that the E911 Five-Year Master Plan be updated to include, but not be limited to, inclusion of a plan for PSAP back-up sites, the Computer Aided Dispatch upgrade, additional changes related to Portable Event Recording Devices, and associated modifications to NRS at the 2019 NV Legislature.
- **Possible Motion:**
 - "Recommend that the Board of County Commissioners direct staff to update the E911 Five-Year Master Plan to include, but not be limited to, inclusion of a plan for PSAP back-up sites, a Computer Aided Dispatch upgrade, additional changes related to Portable Event Recording Devices, and associated modifications to NRS at the 2019 NV Legislature."
