SUBJECT: Request for funding to purchase of twenty-four (24) 22” monitors and four (4) 27” monitors for the additional 4 dispatch workstations to be installed at Sparks PSAP. [For possible action] - A review, discussion, and possible action to approve, deny or otherwise modify a request for funding for the costs associated with purchasing twenty-four (24) 22” monitors and four (4) 27” monitors, for a cost not to exceed \$5,000.

SUMMARY

[For possible action] - A review, discussion, and possible action to approve, deny or otherwise modify a request for approval to purchase twenty-four (24) 22” monitors and four (4) 27” monitors, for a cost not to exceed \$5,000.

NRS APPLICABLE:

NRS 244A.7641 Provides approval of costs associated with purchasing, leasing or renting, wireless technology, facilities, or equipment and technology, facilities, or equipment used for transmitting information from an emergency responder to the user or from the user to an emergency responder.

STAKEHOLDER REVIEW(s)

Stakeholder is Sparks Police Department Public Safety answering Point.

PREVIOUS ACTION

In January 2020, the committee voted unanimously to purchase monitors for Washoe County’s PSAP.

BACKGROUND

Sparks PSAP started planning an update/remodel and expansion in 2019. Part of the plan was to increase the number of dispatch workstations to accommodate the growing needs of the City of Sparks and make room to temporarily accommodate at least one of the PSAP’s if needed.

The current update/remodel plans for Sparks PSAP includes the increase from six (6) dispatch workstations to ten (10) dispatch workstations. The request for funding to purchase four (4) additional Computer Aided Dispatch Workstations is a vital component that will allow all ten (10) workstations to be fully functional. The addition of the monitors is required for use of each of these workstations.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Enhanced 911 Fund is a special revenue fund which receives revenue pursuant to NRS 244A.7643 in the form of telephone surcharges collected to support the emergency reporting system.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the 911 Emergency Response Advisory Committee approve the request for funding to purchase four (4) additional Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) workstations to be installed at Sparks PSAP for a cost not to exceed \$6,100.

POSSIBLE MOTION

Move to approve the request from Sparks PSAP for funding to purchase twenty-four (24) 22” monitors and four (4) 27” monitors, for a cost not to exceed \$5,000.
