**SUMMARY**

**AXON CONFERENCE FOR PRIMARY WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF'S AXON BODY WORN FLEET CAMERA SYSTEMS STAFF**

A review, discussion, and possible action to approve, deny, or otherwise modify a request to fund/reimburse for the costs associated with AXON Conference for a total cost not to exceed \$3,000.00 through fiscal year 21/22.

**PREVIOUS ACTION & BACKGROUND**

NRS 244A.7645 provides approval of costs associated with maintenance, upgrade and replacement of equipment necessary for the operation of the enhanced telephone system. On January 16, 2018, the BCC adopted the policy of the Use of 911 Surcharge Funds for the Body Camera Mandate set forth in Nevada Senate Bill 176.

The E911 Emergency Response Advisory board meeting has previously approved training monies to be reimbursed to agencies for various training conferences that support the mission of the 911 Emergency Response Advisory Committee.

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office is requesting to seek reimbursement to send two staff members to the Axon Conference in November of 2021. These staff members are responsible for installing, troubleshooting, repairing, maintaining, inventory, redaction, and downloading the AXON Body Worn and Fleet Camera systems for the Washoe County Sheriff's Office.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The Enhanced 911 Fund is a special revenue fund which receives revenue pursuant to NRS 244A.7643 in the form of telephone surcharges collected to support the emergency reporting

system. Budget authority exists within the E911 Fund to the travel and training to the public safety training conferences for registrations, seminars, and meetings.
