SUMMARY

AXON ACCELERATE CONFERENCE FOR RENO POLICE DEPARTMENT'S AXON BODY WORN CAMERA SYSTEMS STAFF

A review, discussion, and possible action to approve, deny, or otherwise modify a request to reimburse for the costs associated with AXON Accelerate Conference November 1-3, 2021, for a total cost not to exceed \$6,000.00.

PREVIOUS ACTION & BACKGROUND

NRS 244A.7645 provides approval of costs associated with training associated with maintaining, updating and operating the equipment, hardware and software necessary for portable event recording devices and vehicular event recording devices or systems that consist of both portable event recording devices and vehicular event recording devices. On January 16, 2018, the BCC adopted the policy of the Use of 911 Surcharge Funds for the Body Camera Mandate set forth in Nevada Senate Bill 176.

The E911 Emergency Response Advisory board meeting has previously approved training monies to be reimbursed to agencies for various training conferences that support the mission of the 911 Emergency Response Advisory Committee.

The Reno Police Department is requesting to seek reimbursement to send four staff members to the Axon Accelerate Conference November 1-3, 2021. These staff members are responsible for the day to day operations including: installing, troubleshooting, repairing, maintaining, inventory, redaction, and downloading the AXON Body Worn and Fleet Camera systems for the Reno Police Department.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Enhanced 911 Fund is a special revenue fund which receives revenue pursuant to NRS 244A.7643 in the form of telephone surcharges collected to support the body worn camera system. Budget authority exists within the E911 Fund for the travel and training to public safety training conferences for registrations, seminars, and meetings.
