SUBJECT: Review, discussion, and possible action to approve Crayon Software Experts LLC quote number 2909229239. The change adds Microsoft Windows Server Data Center Core licensing (quantity of 64) to cover the additional servers added through HPE Change Order 3, DL360 GEN 10 Growth (the upgraded servers), at the primary (Washoe County) site. The change order outlines the financial, operational, and contractual implications of this modification, with an annual fiscal impact of [\$37,696.64] over the 60-month term, totaling [\$188,483.20]. SUMMARY

Review, discussion, and possible action to approve Crayon Software Experts LLC quote: 3909229239. The change adds Windows Server DC Core licensing (quantity of 64) to cover the additional Servers added through HPE Change Order 3, DL360 GEN 10 Growth (the upgraded servers), at the primary (Washoe County) site. The change order outlines the financial, operational, and contractual implications of this modification, with an annual fiscal impact of [\$37,696.64] over the 60-month term, totaling [\$188,483.20].

PREVIOUS ACTION

On September 19, 2023, at the Board of County Commission, Quinn Korbolic, IT Manager for the Regional Services Division, Technology Services Department, presented a staff report recommending approval of a contract between Washoe County and Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) for equipment and services to support the upgrade of the regional Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Law Enforcement Records Management (RMS) systems. The contract was initiated through the State of Nevada Cooperative Cloud Solutions agreement (NASPO ValuePoint - Utah). The Board approved it for a cost not to exceed \$62,493.84 in the first year, with a term of sixty months from the effective date. The Board also directed the Purchasing and Contracts Manager to complete the contract. The motion was made in open session and approved by a majority vote of the Board. The meeting minutes reflect that the contract was intended to provide

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primary and backup technology infrastructure for the regional Unified CAD and law enforcement RMS project, and that the HPE agreement costs were included in a regional cost-sharing formula among partner agencies. The staff report and minutes further document that the HPE GreenLake platform was selected to ensure compliance with the State of Nevada's cooperative purchasing requirements and to support regional public safety modernization efforts.

BACKGROUND

The supporting Crayon Software Experts LLC quote 3909229239 allows Washoe County to apply the 64 additional Microsoft Windows Data Center Licenses to the expanded HPE DL360 GEN 10 Growth (the upgraded servers) at the primary (Washoe County) site. The same HPE change order mentioned included the Microsoft Windows Data Center Licensing for the secondary site (Equinox). Washoe County is managing all primary site licensing, while the HPE group is managing the secondary site.

RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends that the Board approve Crayon Software Experts LLC's quote: 3909229239. The change adds Microsoft Windows Server Data Center Core licensing (quantity of 64) to cover the additional Servers added through HPE Change Order 3, DL360 GEN 10 Growth (the upgraded servers), at the primary (Washoe County) site. The change order outlines the financial, operational, and contractual implications of this modification, with an annual fiscal impact of [\$37,696.64] over the 60-month term, totaling [\$188,483.20].

POSSIBLE MOTION

Should the Board agree with the staff's recommendation, a possible motion would be: "Move to approve Crayon quote 3909229239 to add Microsoft Server Data Licensing to the primary site (Washoe County) and authorize Washoe County Technology Services to purchase the licensing."
