The Washoe County Board of County Commissioners will consider an increase to the 911 telephone line surcharge. This increase will help recover the costs of a Portable Event Recorder Program (body-worn and vehicle-mounted cameras) for regional uniformed peace officers, as required and authorized by NRS 289.830, as amended by Nevada Senate Bill ("SB") 176 (2017). The proposed increase will support Portable Event Recorder Programs for the City of Reno Police Department, the City of Sparks Police Department, the Washoe County Sheriff's Office and the City of Reno and City of Sparks Municipal Courts' Marshals.

Washoe County's 911 telephone line surcharge is currently set at \$0.25 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange of a telecommunications provider; \$0.25 per month for each telephone number assigned a customer by a supplier of mobile telephone service (including VoIP); and \$2.50 per month for each customer trunk line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each customer trunk line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each sphone number assigned to a customer of mobile telephone service (including VoIP); and \$1.00 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each government access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each government access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each customer trunk line to the local exchange of a telecommunications provider.
