

# 2022 CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

## **JUSTICE OF THE PEACE**

### *Nonpartisan Office*

<b><u>Term of Office:</u></b>	Six-year term (NRS 4.025)
<b><u>Term Limits:</u></b>	None
<b><u>Age Requirement:</u></b>	18 years of age at the time of election (Nevada Constitution, Art. 2, Sec.1; Art. 15, Sec. 3)
<b><u>Voter Status:</u></b>	Must be a qualified elector (Nevada Constitution, Art. 2, Sec. 1), (NRS 293.485)
<b><u>Ineligible:</u></b>	If ever been removed or retired from any judicial office by the Commission on Judicial Discipline. A person <b>IS</b> still eligible if a decision to remove or retire him from a judicial office is pending appeal before the Supreme Court or has been overturned by the Supreme Court
<b><u>Other:</u></b>	Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. (NRS 4.010 (1)) Reno/Verdi Justice of the Peace and Sparks Justice of the Peace, additionally must be licensed attorneys admitted to practice law in the courts of the State of Nevada at the time of election or appointment, and have been licensed and admitted to practice law in the State of Nevada, another state or the District of Columbia for not less than 5 years at any time preceding election or appointment. (NRS 4.010 (2b))
<b><u>Residency Requirements:</u></b>	30 days next preceding the date of the close of filing of declarations of candidacy for the office he seeks (NRS 293.1755 (1))
<b><u>Filing fee:</u></b>	\$100.00, payable by cash, certified check or cashier's check (NRS 293.193)
<b><u>Elected by:</u></b>	Respective Township
